

## **EXTENDED ANNUAL REPORT ON SDG 11 OF NAMANGAN STATE UNIVERSITY FOR 2024**

On the basis of cooperation between Namangan State University and the Namangan Regional Department of Internal Affairs, the “Courage” Museum was established at the Namangan Academic Lyceum of the Ministry of Internal Affairs. 
## IT PARK

An online meeting was organized via the Zoom platform with the participation of faculty members from the Faculty of Social Sciences at Namangan State University and professors from the Pirogov National Research Medical University of Russia.

At the Faculty of Social Sciences of Namangan State University, a special online lecture was delivered by Professor Pelin Pınar Giritlioğlu from Turkey for students studying sociology, archival studies, and archaeology.

Today, according to this agreement, three Chinese archaeological specialists visited Namangan State University: Sun Man Li, Professor at the School of Cultural Heritage of Northwest University of China and Deputy Director of the Professional Committee on Preservation and Reinforcement of Ancient Monuments of the Chinese Society of Rock Mechanics and Engineering; Li U Cheng, Deputy Director of the Professional Education Committee of the Chinese Cultural Heritage Preservation Technology Association of the same university; and Zhao Xing, an archaeologist with over thirty publications in international journals on cultural heritage preservation.



Students from Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University participated in archaeological research at the Buvonamozor archaeological site in Chust District, in collaboration with professors and students of the Faculty of Social Sciences at Namangan State University.
