

Information on the Educational events of Namangan State University for wider community Regarding Sustainable Development Goals

In 2024, measures were taken to increase the employment level of graduates, familiarize young people with the ongoing socio-political and economic processes in the country, and democratic reforms, as well as to develop their sense of involvement in national reforms and enhance their social activity.

The initiatives also aimed to widely promote among youth the opportunities and favorable conditions created for them in the country, to explain in detail that the responsibility for making effective use of these opportunities rests with them, thereby eliminating a sense of dependency and fostering entrepreneurial skills.

Furthermore, talented young creators who contribute to the socio-economic and cultural development of the country, and gifted and socially active youth achieving success in the fields of science and education, are comprehensively supported.

The “Career Day” employment fair was opened by Dilshodjon Kholmatov, Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs of Namangan State University. First, he highlighted the university’s achievements to date, the establishment of new educational programs in the framework of international cooperation, as well as opportunities for students to undergo internships abroad. He also informed graduates about the existing vacancies in employer organizations and measures to ensure their employment.

The second part of the event included meetings between graduates and representatives of key employer organizations. In their designated auditoriums, graduates and employer representatives learned skills for searching for suitable positions in the labor market, career orientation for graduates, current and future trends in the labor market, and received updated information about specific professions, workplaces, employers, and prospective enterprises. Agreements were also reached with employers according to graduates’ specialties.

During the event, 73 agreements were signed between employers and students. For 2024, arrangements were made for 380 students to complete internships at 13 enterprises and organizations, as well as agreements for their future employment.

On January 6, 2024, at the initiative of the Namangan Regional Department of Justice, an open doors event titled “Journey to Justice: A Hundred-Year Path” was held. Faculty members and students of the Law Faculty of Namangan State University participated in the event.

The event was opened by the Head of the Namangan Regional Department of

Justice, H. Sobirov, who outlined the goals and objectives of the event. Subsequently, participants visited the Namangan Regional Agency of Public Services. During the visit, participants received detailed information about the activities and services of the State Services Agency, and specialists answered questions of interest to them.
