

Namangan State University Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment Report (2024)

Report on the Fight Against Discrimination and Support for Women

Throughout the year, various roundtable discussions and events were held with the participation of female students and faculty members. Additionally, for 5 socially vulnerable female students listed in the social protection register, 50% of their tuition fees were covered by members of the University Women's Council.

Roundtable: “Violence – the End of Life”

On December 16, 2024, the University Women's Advisory Council held a roundtable for all female employees. Speakers included Major F. Ibragimova, Senior Inspector of the Namangan City Department of Internal Affairs, Youth Affairs Division, and Inspector Z. Karimova (University Preventive Officer). Major Ibragimova discussed domestic violence cases involving husbands, in-laws, and other family members. At the end, Faculty of Philology Women's Advisor M. Saidova expressed gratitude to participants.

Event: “We Are Against Violence”

On January 30, 2024, an event was held under the guidance of Women's Affairs Advisor Saodat Usmonova. Participants included female students of the Preschool, Primary Education, and Physical Culture Faculties, professors, teachers, and local NGO representatives. The event promoted awareness on combating violence against women and emphasized mechanisms for medical, psychological, social, pedagogical, and legal support to affected women.

Implementation of Legal Frameworks

Measures were taken in accordance with: the Law “On the Protection of Women from Oppression and Violence,” the Law “On Guarantees of Equal Rights and Opportunities for Women and Men,” and the “Gender Equality Strategy of Uzbekistan until 2030” (Senate Resolution No. SQ-297-IV, May 28, 2021).

Roundtable on “Women’s Rights and Combating Discrimination”

On September 28, 2024, at the Faculty of Social Sciences, a discussion was held on combating discrimination and violence against women. Participants included University Inspector Z. Karimova, Psychologist Z. Rahimova, and Women’s Advisor M. Burxanova. The discussion addressed gender equality and the prevention of violence against women. Students emphasized women’s education, financial independence, and respect within families.

International Women’s Day Celebration

On March 6, 2024, in honor of March 8, the university recognized the devoted work of female faculty members with letters of appreciation and gifts. Female students from Buvaida District were congratulated and gifted books by Advisor M. Payzibayeva.

Ramadan Month Charity Activities

During Ramadan, the Women’s Advisory Council organized an iftar for female dormitory students. On April 4, 2024, faculty members and students visited Specialized School No. 49 in Namangan to provide gifts and a performance for children with special needs. Trainings on “Women and Children’s Health” and “Family is a Sacred Institution” were also held.

Psychological and Legal Consultation Day

In accordance with the Cabinet of Ministers Resolution (No. 06/1-525, September 25, 2023), a Day of Psychological and Legal Consultation for Women was organized on May 4, 2024, with participation from judges and inspectors. They discussed judicial reforms and gender equality and answered students' questions.

Roundtable: “Betraying the Family Means Betraying Your Destiny”

On May 15, 2024, marking International Family Day, a discussion was held with female students. Speakers emphasized the sanctity of family, mutual respect, and the negative effects of infidelity. Students were informed about protection orders for victims of domestic pressure.

Festival of National Values

On May 15, 2024, the university organized the “Festival of National Values,” where students showcased national traditions to promote patriotism and moral health among youth.

Gender Equality Discussions

On September 26, 2024, a meeting was held among 4th-year female students to discuss gender equality and the prevention of crime. Speakers included Associate Professor DSc. Dilafroz Muminova, Advisor M. Payzibayeva, and Inspector X. Karimova. They highlighted the importance of equal rights between men and women in all areas of life.

Discussion on “Healthy Lifestyle and Reproductive Health”

On November 16, 2024, and November 19, 2024, roundtables were held at the Pedagogy and Social Sciences faculties on “Healthy Lifestyle,” “Reproductive Health,” “Preventing Early Marriage and Childbirth,” and

“Healthy Mother – Healthy Child.” Medical experts provided advice, and students engaged in active discussions.

Master Class: Introducing Children to National Heroes

Faculty members led a master class at Preschool No. 27 in Chust District to introduce children to Uzbekistan’s history, heroes, traditions, and holidays. A puppet show based on an Uzbek folk tale was performed to instill national pride and respect for heritage.
